- In the heading of your entry, include First and Last Name, Student ID #, and Classification (sophomore, junior, senior).

My Place in the World, Coming of Age, A Life's Celebration, The Awkwardness of the Ordinary, Innovation, Sanity and/or Insanity, Why I Believe, Who Am I?, The Path I Must Follow, etc.
