You can also access the following through MyIRSC:

Student ID # | Rivermail address | Pay for PERT| Transcripts

First time MyIRSC users: Your pin is the two digits of your birth month and the last two digits of your birth year. Born January 2000, your pin is 0100.

If you do not know your student ID#, you can use your Social Security # and pin# to access MyIRSC. Once in MyIRSC, you can access your student ID#.

Access to Blackboard and Rivermail is now one log in via My Pioneer Portal after set up is completed
