Continue to research career options and consider possible college majors that will help you achieve your career goals. Remember to set up an appointment with Ms. Jones to create your fall schedule and with your IRSC Advisor for your *Guided Pathway*, if you haven't done so already.

Grade 11

When selecting your senior courses, continue to challenge yourself academically. Register for the June SAT or June ACT (if you have not previously tested). Continue to evaluate your list of colleges and add or delete from your list as appropriate. Look into summer jobs or apply for special summer academic or enrichment programs.

Be sure to view or review the Internship Info Session from Thursday, April 2, to stay aligned to the timeline and expectations set by Dr. Bonds for *Rising Seniors*.

Grade 12

Review your college acceptances and financial aid awards. Be sure to compare financial aid packages in your decision-making process. If you are positive you will NOT enroll at one or more of the colleges that accepted you, inform college(s) that you have selected another college. If you know which college you will attend, send your tuition deposit and follow all other instructions for admitted students. Accept offer of admission by May 1st (postmark deadline).

Many colleges are extending deadlines so check with your particular college to make sure everything is submitted on time.
