As promised, now that I am back at work, here is last week's news and another e-news will be sent Thursday of this week.

Safety Information

This morning, shortly after 11:00 am, per request of the Martin County Sheriff's Office (MCSO), Clark and IRSC went into lockOUT status. You should've received a text/phone call and subsequent email about this situation as soon as we were able to send. As shared in the email blast to parents, a resident at the behavioral health center nearby left without permission and was apprehended by authorities within approximately 20-25 minutes. LockOUTS (external potential threat- caution being taken) are different than lockDOWNS (internal threat and choice to evacuate or shelter in place as practiced). This has been shared at parent and student meetings, emails, and students and staff practice safety drills monthly as required by current statute. I have attached the Standard Response Protocol (SRP) adopted by the MCSD (and Clark) that gives a simple explanation for all potential emergencies a school might face. In short, we are able to override our outer doors in an emergency so that even an ID card will not work to gain entrance. All students remained in their classrooms with restricted movement and staff members, including our SRO, monitored all exits/entrances. Ms. Judd visited each classroom to make sure students were safe and understood the lockout status. We communicate as quickly as possible once there is a situation and therefore, if you did not receive ANY notification, please contact Ms. Judd at <u>ljudd@irsc.edu</u> 772-419-5758 or Mrs. Kohuth <u>dkohuth@irsc.edu</u> 772-419-5751 so we ensure your contact info is current.

The staff and students here on campus did a wonderful job and we want to ensure you all that they were safe. If you have feedback for us or questions, do not hesitate to ask.
