


#### **Chief Judge Maurice B. Foley**

Judge Foley was appointed to the United States Tax Court by President William J. Clinton on April 9, 1995; reappointed by President Barack Obama on November 25, 2011; and elected as Chief Judge for a 2-year term effective June 1, 2018 and re-elected February 21, 2020 for a second 2-year term effective June 1, 2020. Judge Foley is an adjunct professor at American University Washington College of Law, the University of Colorado Law School, the University of Baltimore School of Law, and the University of San Diego School of Law.
