RULES

- Must be an original design by the artist
- Must say “I Voted” or “I Voted in Martin County” in the design
- Submissions must be non-partisan. You may not reference any political party or candidates.
- Consider elements representative of Martin County
- Must be willing to allow us to use artwork for upcoming elections

HOW TO ENTER

- Artwork can be hand drawn (paint, watercolor, marker) or digital (see specifications below)
- Actual Artwork must be in the shape of an oval using the following dimensions for hand drawn: 8.5” x 11” or smaller (if it fits inside an oval).
- Electronic Artwork dimensions: 2.5” w x 1.5” high, oval shape, full color, minimum of 300 dpi, vector artwork is preferred.
- Artwork must be full color
- Fill out and sign the submission form provided and turn it in with your completed design
- Design must be submitted to your teacher by the deadline they provide, for the Elections Office to pick up.
