Celebrating Outstanding Accomplishments

- Clark has been designated a Grade “A” school by the State of Florida for sixteen consecutive years.
- Clark is recognized as a High-Performing Charter School and designated as a School of Excellence by the Florida Department of Education.
- Associate degrees have been earned by more than 61% of the Class of 2026.
- Clark seniors collectively complete more than 3,000 hours in the local community through Internships each year in cooperation with over 50 community business partners.
- College readiness rates for the Class of 2026 demonstrated 100% college readiness in English, 99% college readiness in reading, and 99% college readiness in math.
- Clark seniors engage in diverse service learning and community projects and accumulated 17,874 service and work hours during high school.
- Clark seniors earned more than \$221,350 in local scholarships and more than \$772,200 in Bright Futures Scholarships.
- Clark seniors have been accepted to more than 45 colleges and universities.
- Clark seniors received local, state, and national honors and recognition:
 - MartinArts Student Performing Artist
 - “Joe Kordick Youth Character Award” selection by Boys and Girls Club of Martin County/Character Counts of Martin County;
 - “Pathfinder” selections by The Palm Beach Post;
- The digital media designs and traditional artwork of Clark students earn top honors in annual competitions, including the Marvin S. Cone Annual High School Juried Art Show and MartinArts Awards.
- Clark students are recognized for academic achievement with induction into the college-level Phi Theta Kappa International Honor Society, as well as Mu Alpha Theta, National Honor Society, National Art Honor Society, and Science National Honor Society for high school academics.
- Clark parents and community members contributed over 7,000 hours of volunteer service to the school in the 25-26 school year.
